Airline alliance survey 2004

The *Airline Business Alliance Survey* provides a snapshot of the current state of co-operation deals between the world's main carriers. The survey focuses on those mainline scheduled passenger carriers that appear in the top 200 traffic ranking. This excludes regional and charter partners, as well as cargo agreements, which are covered in other Special Reports throughout the year. Links that only extend to a frequent flyer programme (FFP) are not included. Membership of the main global alliances – oneworld, SkyTeam and Star – are indicated to the right of the name bar and have not been included in their own right in the listing unless a specific bilateral exists. Full details of the global groupings are given on page 48. Data for the listing was compiled in association with *Airline Business* by sister online service *Air Transport Intelligence* (www.rati.com).

Notes , definitions & summary

This survey covers close to 500 alliances among around 120 mainline passenger airlines, representing a snapshot of major co-operation deals in place at the start of June 2004.

Airlines included: The survey covers only those mainline scheduled passengers carriers which appeared in the Top 200 ranking by passenger traffic. Alliances among regional, charter and cargo carriers are covered in other reports during the year.

Sources: Data is largely sourced from airline questionnaire returns over the first half of 2004 but with a final cut-off at the start of June.

Parent/shareholders: Significant shareholders have been listed where they are declared but the overall percentages may not always total 100%.

Shareholdings: These cover holdings in other carriers, including regional cargo and charter operators, but exclude non-flying operations.

Dates: The dates listed refer to the time when the co-operation started, but where this is not clear, the date of the agreement has been included. Pending agreements have only been included where the deal is signed but regulatory approval is delaying start-up.

Exclusions: The survey does not include co-operation based only on frequent flyer programme (FFP) links, interline agreements, special pro-rates or non-flying-related joint ventures, but they are noted if they are a component of a deeper arrangement.

Data collation: Data for the survey has been collated by *Air Transport Intelligence* (ATI), the on-line sister service to *Airline Business*. For further


