REPORTS ON ACTS OF PIRACY AND ARMED ROBBERY AGAINST SHIPS

Annual report – 2007

1 The Maritime Safety Committee, at its sixty-fifth session in May 1995, instructed the Secretariat to issue, as from 31 July 1995, monthly reports of all incidents of piracy and armed robbery against ships reported to the Organization and, in addition, on a quarterly basis, composite reports accompanied by an analysis, on a regional basis, of the situation and an indication whether the frequency of incidents is increasing or decreasing and advising on any new feature or pattern of significance.

2 At its sixty-sixth session in June 1996, the Committee further instructed the Secretariat to prepare, after March of every year, an annual summary of all acts of piracy and armed robbery against ships, which had occurred during the previous year and had been reported to the Organization, based on their actual date and time of occurrence.

3 Pursuant to this request, the annex hereto provides information on reports of piracy and armed robbery against ships received by the Secretariat since 1984, when relevant statistics started being compiled and, in particular, those which occurred in the course of 2007 as well as a regional analysis thereof.

4 The number of acts of piracy and armed robbery against ships, which were reported to the Organization to have occurred or to have been attempted in 2007, was 282, a increase of 41 (17%) over the figure for 2006.

5 From the information referred to above, it emerges that the areas most affected in 2007 were the Far East, in particular the South China Sea and the Malacca Strait, West Africa, South America and the Caribbean*, the Indian Ocean and East Africa. Over the period under review, the number of acts reported to have occurred or to have been attempted increased from 66 to 67 in the South China Sea, from 31 to 60 in East Africa and from 31 to 60 in West Africa. There was a decrease from 53 to 40 in the Indian Ocean, from 22 to 12 in the Malacca Strait, and from 31 to 25 in South America and the Caribbean, over the 2006 figures. Most of the attacks worldwide were reported to have occurred or to have been attempted in the coastal States' concerned territorial waters while the ships were at anchor or berthed. In many of the reports received, the crews were violently attacked by groups of five to ten people carrying knives or guns.

* As reported to MSC 76 (MSC 76/23, paragraph 16.2), the geographically large South American and Caribbean region has been sub-divided into three regions: South America (Atlantic), South America (Pacific) and the Caribbean. This change is reflected in all relevant reports issued as of 1 January 2003.

6 From the same information, it emerges that, during the period under review, twenty (20) crew members were killed, over one hundred and fifty-three (153+) crew members were reportedly injured/assaulted. About one hundred and ninety four (194) crew members were reportedly taken hostage/kidnapped. A vessel and crew and another three (3) crew members were reportedly still unaccounted for, and sixteen ships (16) were reportedly hijacked.

7 The total number of incidents of piracy and armed robbery against ships, reported to have occurred or to have been attempted from 1984 to the end of December 2007, has risen to 4515.

8 With regard to acts of piracy and armed robbery against ships reported to the Organization, information on acts of piracy and armed robbery against ships reported to the Organization to have occurred or to have been attempted during 2007 has been circulated by means of monthly reports (MSC.4/Circ.99, MSC.4/Circ.100, MSC.4/Circ.101, MSC.4/Circ.102, MSC.4/Circ.103, MSC.4/Circ.104, MSC.4/Circ.107, MSC.4/Circ.108, MSC.4/Circ.109, MSC.4/Circ.111, MSC.4/Circ.112 and MSC.4/Circ.113) and quarterly reports (MSC.4/Circ.105, MSC.4/Circ.106, MSC.4/Circ.110 and MSC.4/Circ.114).

9 The annexes to this document provide a breakdown of the information referred to above as follows:

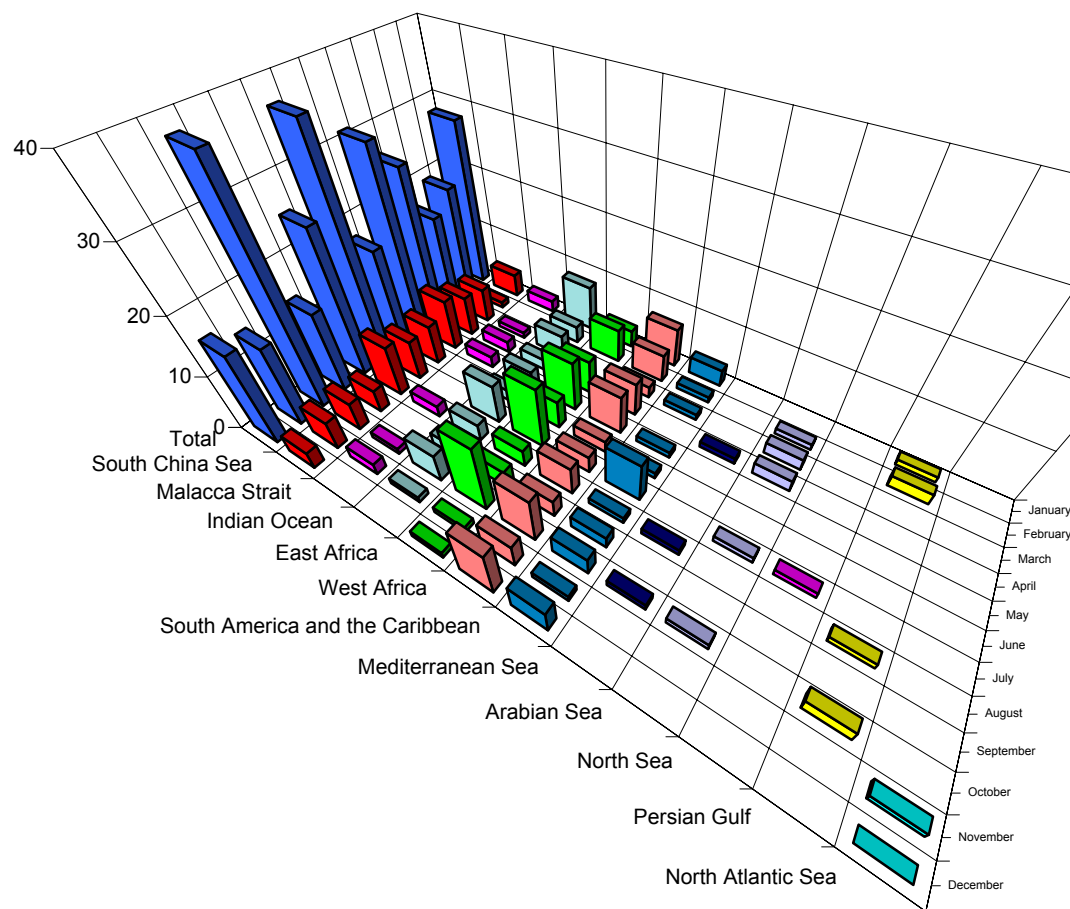

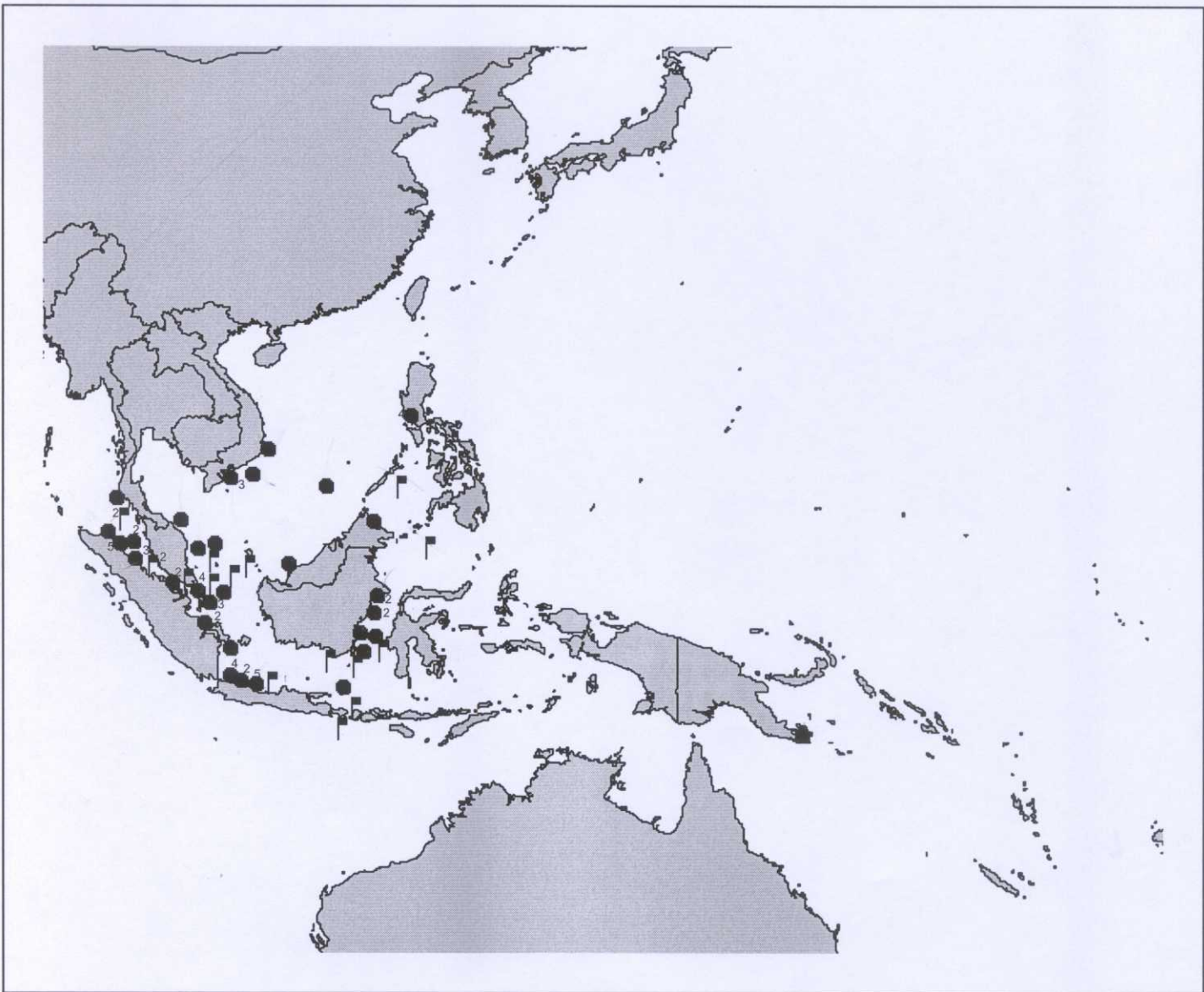

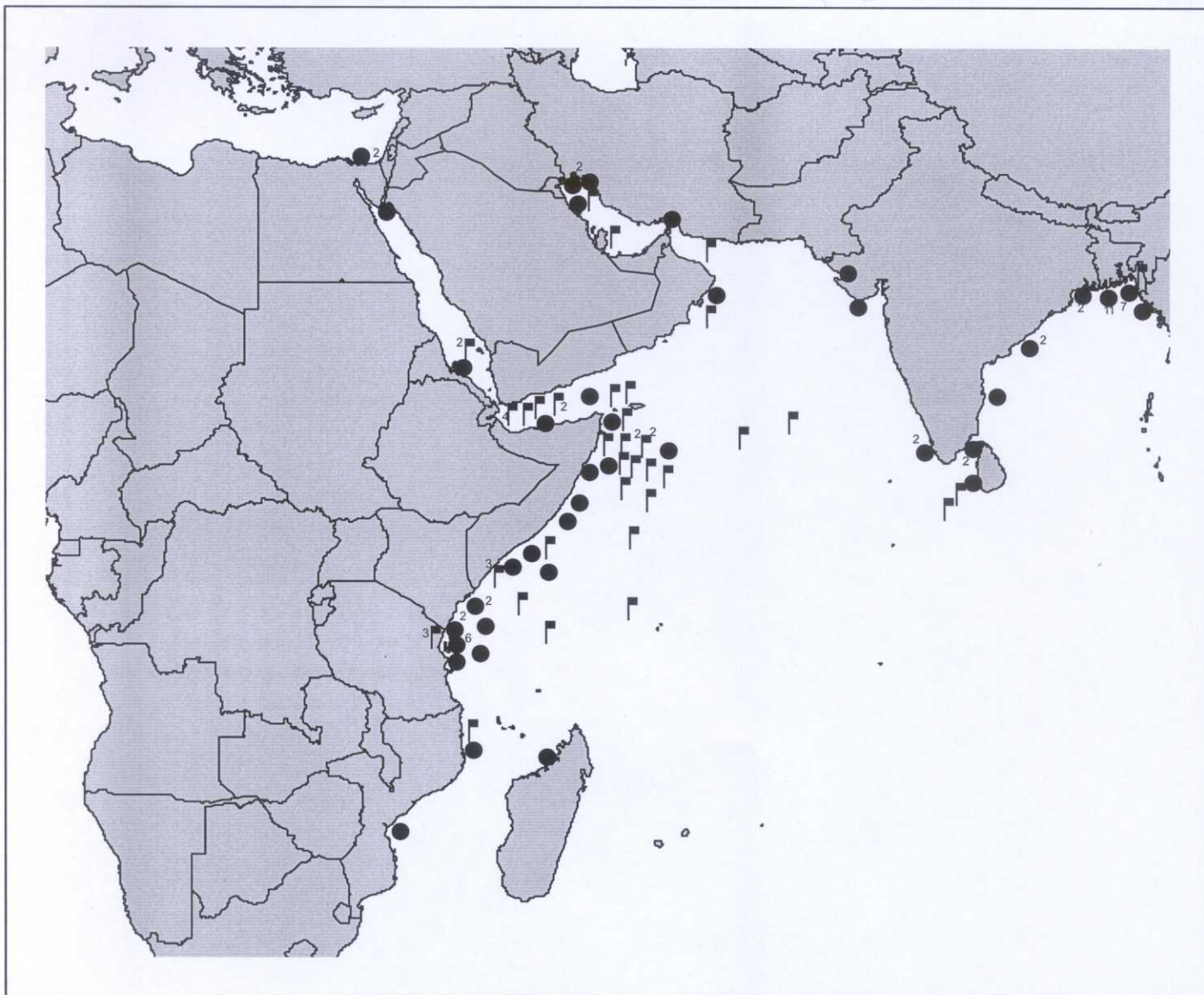

SOUTH CHINA SEA AND MALACCA STRAIT



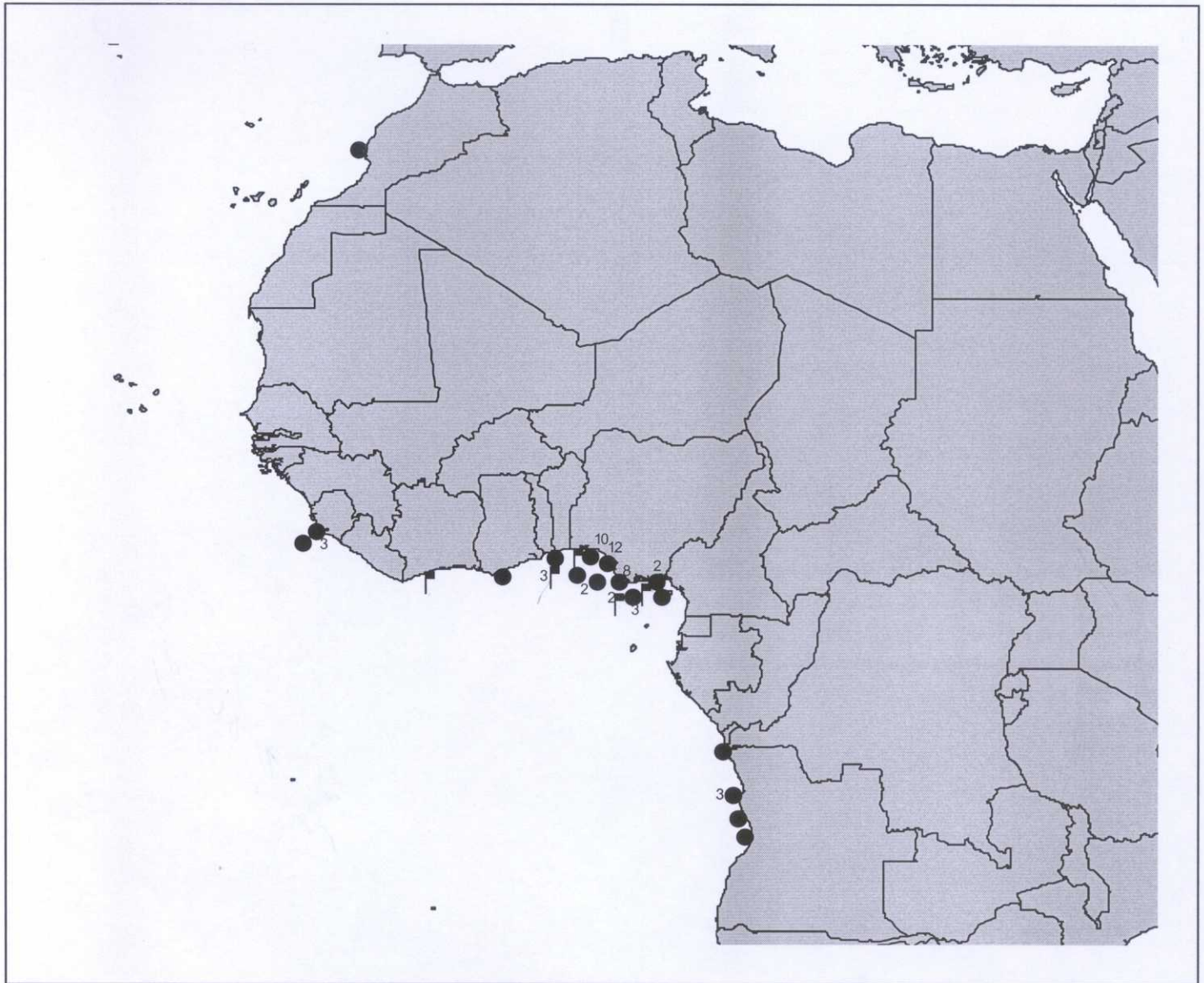
