Information on simulators available for use in maritime training

SUMMARY

<i>Executive summary:</i>	This document seeks information regarding simulators available in training institutions world-wide
<i>Action to be taken:</i>	Paragraph 4
<i>Related documents:</i>	MSC/Circ.576/Rev.1, MSC/Circ.633, MSC/Circ.721 and MSC/Circ.852

1 The Maritime Safety Committee, at its sixty-third session (16 to 25 May 1994), instructed the Secretariat to compile, from the replies received in response to MSC/Circ.567/Rev.1, a list of maritime training institutions equipped with simulators, to provide a source of information on availability of such training for use by administrations, shipowners and others. The first list was circulated as MSC/Circ.633 and subsequent information as MSC/Circ.721 and MSC/Circ.852.

2 Many simulators at the existing training institutions may have been replaced or new simulators may have been installed at other training institutions. It would therefore be appropriate to update the information contained in these circulars at an early date to provide Member States up to date information.

3 Accordingly, the Sub-Committee may consider requesting Member Governments to provide the Secretariat updated information in order to compile new circular containing information on the availability of simulators available in maritime training institutions.
