Dispensations issued under Article VIII of the STCW Convention

Note by the Secretariat

SUMMARY

<i>Executive summary:</i>	This document provides information on submissions made by STCW Parties in accordance with Article VIII of the STCW Convention on dispensations granted by them during the year 2004
<i>Action to be taken:</i>	Paragraph 3
<i>Related document:</i>	STW 36/16

1 Article VIII of the 1978 STCW Convention - Dispensations, requires that Parties “as soon as possible after 1 January of each year, send a report to the Secretary-General giving information of the total number of dispensations in respect of each capacity for which a certificate is required that have been issued during the year to sea-going ships, together with information as to the numbers of those ships above and below 1,600 gross register tons respectively”.

2 In accordance with the said Article, the Secretary-General has been notified by a number of Parties of dispensations they have granted during the year 2004. The information, provided by the Governments of Antigua and Barbuda, Cyprus, Finland, Greece, India, Lithuania, Norway, Panama, Papua New Guinea and Portugal is summarized in the annex. As a number of Parties have elected to replace 1,600 gross registered tons by 3,000 gross tonnage on the certificates, the format for reporting to the Sub-Committee approved by the Maritime Safety Committee (MSC 52/28, paragraph 25.9) has been amended to include information presented by Parties on the numbers of ships above and below 3,000 GT.
